VILLAGE OF PEMBERTON

BYLAW No. 748, 2013

A Bylaw to authorize the closure of a portion of dedicated road.

WHEREAS pursuant to the *Community Charter*, Council may by bylaw close to traffic a portion of a highway that is vested in the municipality and to remove its dedication as a highway;

AND WHEREAS, Council now deems it advisable to stop up and close to traffic and remove the dedication of that portion of road legally defined as that 0.403 ha area shown in heavy black outline on Reference Plan EPP36650, dedicated as road on plan EPP21848, District Lot 211, Lillooet District, a copy of which plan is attached hereto as Schedule A and forms part of this Bylaw (the "Closed Road");

AND WHEREAS the Closed Road is no longer required for road purposes as the alignment has been redesigned;

AND WHEREAS the Village of Pemberton has advertised notice of intention to adopt this Bylaw as required under the *Community Charter*;

NOW THEREFORE be it resolved that the Council for the Village of Pemberton in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

- 1. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the "Village of Pemberton Recreation Site Road Closure Bylaw No. 748, 2013".
- 2. All that portion of the Closed Road is hereby stopped up and closed to traffic and the dedication as road is hereby removed.
- On deposit of all documentation for the closure of the Closed Road in the Kamloops Land Title Office, the Closed Road is stopped up and closed to public traffic, the dedication is removed and it shall cease to be a public highway.
- 4. The Mayor and Corporate Officer are hereby authorized to execute all documentation necessary to give effect to the provisions of this Bylaw, including the plan attached hereto.

Pursuant to section 40 (3) of the *Community Charter*, notice of Council's intention was advertised in the Thursday, December 5th, 2013 and Thursday, December 12th, 2013 editions of "The Pique Newsmagazine" and an opportunity was given to persons who considered they are affected by this bylaw to make representation to Council at the December 17th, 2013 Council Meeting.

READ A SECOND TIME this 17th day of December, 2013.

READ A THIRD TIME this 17th day of December, 2014.
