## THE CORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF PEMBERTON BYLAW NO. 644, 2010

Being a bylaw to amend the Village of Pemberton Sewer Rates Bylaw No 628, 2009.

**WHEREAS** it is deemed necessary to amend the rates and charges and billing system for the use of the Sanitary Sewer System to meet increased operational costs of the system;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Village of Pemberton, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1. Schedule "A" of, Amendment Bylaw No. 628, 2009 is hereby deleted and replaced with a new Schedule "A" which is attached hereto and forms part of this bylaw, and which takes effect on January 1, 2010.
  - c) Utility billing for 2010 is done on an annual basis providing residents the option to pay quarterly with no penalty before December 31st.
  - d) A 10% penalty will be added to such rates, rents and charges remaining unpaid after December 31, 2010.
- 2. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the "Village of Pemberton Sanitary Sewer System Regulation Connection and Rates Amendment Bylaw No. 644, 2010."
