

VILLAGE OF PEMBERTON

BYLAW NO. 600, 2007

A Bylaw to Provide for Tax Exemption for Municipal Held Property.

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 224 (2) (b) (i) of the *Community Charter*, a Council may, by bylaw, exempt land or improvements, or both, from taxation under Section 197 (1) (a), for the next five (5) calendar years;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to enact a new bylaw granting exemption to Municipal held properties;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Village of Pemberton in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

1. The land hereinafter described and the improvements thereon which are set apart and in use for Municipal buildings and/or purposes, are hereby exempt from taxation under Section 197 (1) (a) of the *Community Charter* for the years 2008 - 2012:
 - (a) Lot 1, Plan 6995, District Lot 203, Lillooet Land District (7400 Prospect Street).
 - (b) Plan A20, District Lot 203, Lillooet Land District
2. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the “Village of Pemberton Tax Exemption for Municipal Held Property Bylaw No. 600, 2007.”
