VILLAGE OF PEMBERTON

BYLAW NO. 600, 2007

A Bylaw to Provide for Tax Exemption for Municipal Held Property.

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 224 (2) (b) (i) of the *Community Charter*, a Council may, by bylaw, exempt land or improvements, or both, from taxation under Section 197 (1) (a), for the next five (5) calendar years;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to enact a new bylaw granting exemption to Municipal held properties;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Village of Pemberton in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

- 1. The land hereinafter described and the improvements thereon which are set apart and in use for Municipal buildings and/or purposes, are hereby exempt from taxation under Section 197 (1) (a) of the *Community Charter* for the years 2008 2012:
 - (a) Lot 1, Plan 6995, District Lot 203, Lillooet Land District (7400 Prospect Street).
 - (b) Plan A20, District Lot 203, Lillooet Land District
- **2.** This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the "Village of Pemberton Tax Exemption for Municipal Held Property Bylaw No. 600, 2007."
